

CLC Booster Club General Meeting Minutes

Treasurer's Report- Bonnie reported that the October through January statements are complete now and all money has been accounted for. The Boosters are about \$6,000 ahead of last year's income at this time. The rest of the allocations for this school year will be paid out after game night. Merchandise- At 8th grade night last week there was about \$4,800 in sales. They are out of a lot of items. February 26th will have a merchandise night at the basketball game.

Outdoor Concessions- The Boosters are in need of a chairman for the outdoor concession stand for next year. It has been suggested to have a committee for outdoors.

Indoor Concessions- The RC change will take place after the Basketball season. There are two games left. Stock may be low for these games.

Fundraising-

Game Night- will be held March 6, 2010 at the Dole Mansion. Sign up forms are on the web site, There are 5 tables left to sell. Any booster able to help set up on March 6th around 2 o'clock please come and help the Game Night Committee. Baskets, Silent Auction items and tags are to be turned in by February 28th to Debbie Freck.

Golf Outing 2010- Monday June 21st around noon at Crystal Woods Golf Course for the CLC annual Golf outing.

Spirit Night at Buffalo Wild Wings- CLC raised over \$900 that will be coming back to the school. They won their spirit night against Woodstock North. Woodstock beat PR and Huntley beat Jacobs. South will go against McHenry this week and the winner will then go against Huntley. CLC will next go against Woodstock. The dates are to be determined. The other schools raised around \$600 or less for their schools. Central is the only school that had the Student Council handle the competition all of the others had the boosters handle it.

Check Awards- It has been decided that we will once again sell check awards. There are 8 teachers that have said they would like to participate for the spring. To eliminate loss of money to the booster the groups will pay for the check awards out of their activity accounts. They will make the deposits and what ever is not sold will then come out of their profits. All organizations must sell the books at the same price and not discount any books.

New Business –

Sound System- The sound system has been and installed. If you have not had a chance to hear it be sure to go to a game. At the pep assembly last week it was great.

2010 Allocation Applications- Applications for next year's allocations will go out in February and are due before Spring Break. Boosters will go over all applications in April and vote in May.

Board Positions- Next year the Boosters will need to have a new Vice President and indoor and outdoor concessions chairman. The concession responsibilities involve stocking the stand, ordering the pizza, and pop. Making sure that there is money for the bank as well as change. The indoor season is October for Volleyball and then November through February for Boys and Girls Basketball and Wrestling. There will be a board member that is the Manager of the Day that will open and Close the stand. Central does not have a large storage area to stock items. Outdoor Concessions need to have a person certified in Food Service Sanitation. The Boosters will pay for the class. Gayl Wylde will put together a description of the jobs which will go on the website and a handout will be at the next meeting.

Kic Leukemia- The February 26th game will partner with Kic Leukemia and have an Orange Out at the game. Student Council will sell T-shirts. In the P.E. Classes that week there will have a presentation on Leukemia. CLC has had a student die from Leukemia.

For the Good of The Cause-- There will also be an Ice cream Social hosted by the junior class and A Drum and Bugle Core will perform at the February 26th game.

Choir and Band are performing at the Raue Center. Girls Basketball has their first regional game on Wednesday at PR. Winner will play Friday.

The Musical will be held the 19th, 20th, and 21st of March.

There are 7 wrestlers going to state this weekend.
