Liaison- Krista was unable to attend. In her absence Debbie Freck asked any liaison who had not been to a meeting earlier in the year to please sign up with her after the meeting.

Outdoor Concessions- The Boosters are in need of a chairman for the outdoor concession stand for next year. It has been suggested to have a committee for outdoors.

Indoor Concessions- District 155 has changed contracts from Pepsi to RC products in the 4 High Schools over break. We will be transitioning the concession stand with new coolers and RC products in the next few weeks.

Fundraising-

Game Night- will be held March 6, 2010 at the Dole Mansion. Sign up forms are on the web site, there are only 32 tables so reserve your spot early. Silent auction items and baskets were discussed with liaisons. Baskets and Silent Auction Items are to be turned in by February 28 to Debbie Freck. You will be sent a template to fill in with the contents of your items via email. We need volunteers to help set up the day of the event and people to help get prizes.

Golf Outing 2010- Monday June 21st around noon at Crystal Woods Golf Course for the CLC annual Golf outing.

Spirit Night at Buffalo Wild Wings- Starting Sunday January 17th there will be commercials on Star 105 promoting Spirit Night at Buffalo Wild Wings between the local high schools. 15% of food and non-alcoholic drink sales will be totaled for each school from start of business to end of business the day of the event. You will need to turn in a form at the time of purchase that can be downloaded from the booster website. You can either Dine in or take out the food. At the end of the competition the winning school will win \$3,000.

New Business –

Sound System- The new sound system will be installed this weekend.

2010 Allocation Applications- Applications for next year's allocations will go out in February and are due before Spring Break. Boosters will go over all applications in April and vote in May.

Check Awards- The liaisons were asked to go back to their respective coaches and sponsors to find out if they want to continue to participate in check awards. The program is time consuming and Bonnie does not have time to organize and keep track of it next time. Many of the sponsors did not sell what they thought they would and turned back the unsold books. We presently have 500 books left to sell. If we continue to sell Check Awards there will be some new rules. The coaches and sponsors will be responsible for the printing cost of any unsold books that they did not sell. Books will be revamped if we sell them again. We will need to have an answer by February to continue the program.

Board Positions- Next year there will be several openings on the board. Including Vice President, Indoor Concession, Possibly outdoor Concessions, Junior Rep and a Freshman Rep.
