Treasurer's Report- The negative number of \$14,994.51 in the treasures report is for the sound system. The money to pay for the sound system was taken out of the money market account. Merchandise- Merchandise sales are just about finished for this year. There will be a sale at the end of the year to get rid of this years styles. Letterman jackets continue to be available year round.

Outdoor Concessions- The Boosters are in need of a chairman for the outdoor concession stand for next year. Track meets will be held in April concessions stand will need to be manned. The girls Regional Soccer games will be held at CLC. Not sure how concessions will be handled due to location of the games and closeness to concessions stands.

Girls track is considering holding a Summer Track Meet and wondered if they would be able to use the concessions stand. The question was who will stock and run the stand. Bob suggested that the coach talk to Doug or Jeff to work out the details. Suggested they could use this as a fundraiser.

Fundraising-

Game Night- was held March 6, 2010 at the Dole Mansion. The boosters cleared \$14,210.04. This was the 5th year of the event and we have raised about \$66,000 for CLC. There may have to be a new category next year for best-decorated table. There were so fancy tables this year.

Golf Outing 2010- Monday June 21st around noon at Crystal Woods Golf Course for the CLC annual Golf outing. It will cost \$100 per person, which includes a box lunch, golf, dinner and prizes. There will be an early bird special if you get your forms in a predetermined date. The golf course can accommodate up to 144 golfers which is 36 foursomes

Spirit Night at Buffalo Wild Wings- The next night will be in the first two weeks of April. CLC will be against Woodstock, and South will be against Huntley. South raised \$100 more than CLC did at their first competition.

Check Awards-The last round of payouts for the fall check awards will be paid out which amounts to \$5000. Only a few coaches wanted to participate this spring in check awards. Cheerleading, Football, Softball and Environmental Science will be offered the leftover fall books. We will place a new order in the fall.

New Business –

2010 Allocation Applications- Applications for next year's allocations will go out in February and are due before Spring Break. Boosters will go over all applications in April and vote in May.

Board Positions- Next year the Boosters will need to have a new Vice President and indoor and outdoor concessions chairman. The concession responsibilities involve stocking the stand, ordering the pizza, and pop. Making sure that there is money for the bank as well as change. The indoor season is October for Volleyball and then November through February for Boys and Girls Basketball and Wrestling. There will be a board member that is the Manager of the Day that will open and Close the stand. Central does not have a large storage area to stock items. Outdoor Concessions need to have a person certified in Food Service Sanitation. The Boosters will pay for the class. We will continue to have the board members be Manager of the Day for all concessions dates.

Bob had all booster members fill out a raffle ticket for the Tappas Dinner for 2 from 1776. It was a prize from Game Night that had not been chosen. The winner of the dinner was Bob and Mary Frazier.

The Musical will be held the 19th, 20th, and 21st of March.
