

# CLC Booster Club General Meeting Minutes

May12, 2010

Meeting called to order at 7:35 p.m.

**Welcome-** Bob Frazier welcomed everyone in attendance and thanked everyone for coming.

**Presidents Report-** The Boosters have allocated \$26,988.97 for next years allocation requests. This past school year we had allocated \$24,000 and also purchased the new sound system. The coaches filled out the allocation request forms and will be notified if their allocation request was approved. It was asked if the liaisons would be able to find out what was approved. We have agreed to put a copy of the allocations in the September treasurers report. Buffalo Wild Wings final challenge is tomorrow.

**Treasurer's Report-** All allocations for the 2009-20010 school year have been paid. We are about \$7000 behind last years total. The Golf outing will be held in June. The Boosters brought in \$138,291.01 this year. \$20,000 was taken out of the money market account to pay for the sound system. There is \$10,000 left in the account. 1<sup>st</sup>. **Merchandise-** Lynda Mauro said there would be a sale on all remaining merchandises this Friday from 10-1 during lunch hours. A little over \$41,000 in merchandise has been sold this year.

**Outdoor Concessions-** Bonnie thanked the track parents for all of their help with the outdoor concession stand. Bonnie is taking requests for what people will want to drink in the fall at the football games. There are 4 home football games next year and five organizations that what to work the games. The board decided that the only fair way was to pick names out of the hat. First name picked will have first game etc. Fifth organization will get a playoff game. The Cary game is Wrestling, Home Coming is Cheerleading, PR game will be Girls Track, Woodstock game is Choir and Band has a playoff game and if not available will do an inside game.

### **Fundraising-**

**Golf Outing 2010-** Monday June 21<sup>st</sup> around noon at Crystal Woods Golf Course. It will cost \$100 per person, which includes a box lunch, golf, dinner and prizes. There will be a price reduction for registering by May 15<sup>th</sup>. We are still looking for sponsorships. All forms are on the web site. We need more people to register to play. If you do not golf you are welcome to come to dinner. Would like to develop the golf outing to have a community feeling the same as game night does.

**Spirit Night at Buffalo Wild Wings-** CLC will have their final night at Buffalo Wild Wings on Thursday They will be competing against Crystal Lake South High School for the \$3000 top prize.

**Check Awards-**Check Awards will run again in the fall. Bonnie collected the wish lists for establishment that could be included in the fall check awards books. There were two businesses that came to us requesting to be included in the books. The planned delivery date is Monday before registration. All organizations will prepay for the books this year all coaches have been made aware of the change.

**Discount Cards-** We will be ordering 1600 discount cards for next year and they also will be available the Monday before registration.

Instead of 50/50 at football games we will have a Tiger Raffle instead. People will buy raffle tickets and a winner will be chosen at each home football game.
