

CLC Booster Club General Meeting Minutes

October 14, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:35 p.m.

Treasurer's Report- Bonnie presented the statements from September. Comparing last years and this years YTD columns this year seems low when actually it is a little ahead of last year. The reason being that this is the time when Bonnie took over as treasurer. And September bills had not been paid. Merchandise- Merchandise will be available at the football games and in the cafeteria on Thursday and Friday before a home game. Outdoor Concessions- Chris Foley has done a fantastic job in organizing the outdoor concession stand this year. The last home game before playoffs will be on October 23rd against Woodstock. Central has already qualified for the playoffs and will not know until the 25th who, when, and where they will be playing.

Indoor Concessions- Melissa sent in a report, as she is sick. Last Friday the concession stand had to be closed because no one showed up to work. There have been requests to bring back the walking taco. We are unable to provide them because it is not a prepackaged product. We are not allowed to have any homemade items in the stand per the Health Department. The Concession Stand Calendar is on the website. Gail Bauman requested that a reminder notice be sent to liaisons before their time to work in the stand. Wrestling will man the concession stand for a

Volleyball tournament on October 29 and 31. If Central has a home game for football playoffs they will man the outdoor concession stand.

Fundraising-

Discount Cards- have been handed out to all groups wishing to sell them this year. There are still some available to sell.

Check Awards- \$11,550 has already been dispensed to organizations. There is still about \$13,000 outstanding. There are three organizations that are having some issues with the check awards.

Walk-a-thon- Will be held October 25th from 11-2. Students will get donations for walking a mile and then will receive a hotdog, pop and a bag of chips at the end. Krista has sent out the information to all coaches and sponsors. The money may be divided between 3 organizations per individual. Any junior walking can have money go towards prom.

Game Night- will be held March 6,2010 at the Dole Mansion again this year. Debbie Freck asked any liaison that was not here last month to please see her before they leave to get info about game night.

Chili's Night and Nicks Pizza Night- CLC made about \$100 from the Nicks Pizza nights. Chili's will be every Wednesday from September to December and will give 10% back in one check in Dec. You will need to download the coupon on the booster website to bring with you for CLC to get credit.

Golf Outing 2010- Sean Thomas and Bob Frazier will be the Chairs. They are planning to have it in June 2010.

New Business –

Sound System- Barry Savage from Pro Audio attended the meeting to answer any questions that we have in regards to his quote. Barry is located in Carpentersville and will be available to come to fix any problems we may have. He said that presently we have the wrong type of speakers in the gym and they are underpowered. He will train anyone who will use the system. His original quote had 8 speakers in the center of the gym, he is now proposing to have 4 and then add speakers to the far end for graduations, pep assemblies etc. He also suggested that we add a sub woofer for music only. The boosters had some questions from his first quote which he partially addressed. One important item the boosters would like to know is the exact speakers he will be providing for the system. He said he will list the speakers in the new quote he submits. Doug Blundy asked if the new system will require more power than the old and wondered if we would be blowing fuses. It was asked if we needed to add more fuses how much would that add, he guessed about 3-4 hundred dollars. We have requested a quote from a third company.
