

# CLC Booster Club General Meeting Minutes

September 9, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:37 p.m.

**Treasurer's Report-** Bonnie presented the statements from over the summer. On paper it looks like there was a negative carry over balance from last year because of the Check Awards confusion. When there really was a \$1900 carry over. The Boosters took in \$ 134,665.83 for last year and have paid out \$6100 for concession stand work and \$38,000 in allocations. **Merchandise-** Sales went very well at registration, selling \$15,000 of merchandise. They have put in a new order to cover the 5 Home football games this year. They will be selling in the cafeteria during lunch every Thursday and Friday before a home game. A new item for merchandise this year is a window cling that is weather resistant and does not obstruct your view from inside. Small one sells for \$10 and the large one is \$15. They will have the flutter-fetti at Homecoming again this year.

**Liaison-** Krista has a liaison letter for people to pick up and fill out all of their information.

**Outdoor Concessions-** There will be 4 consecutive home games this year. Will be trying a veggie burger out for the first game for all of the health conscious people this year. The Pork chop sandwich has to go on the back burner for right now.

**Indoor Concessions-** There are a few opening to fill for the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the year, any organization wishing to claim one please check with Krista. There have been 2 games where the liaisons did not show up to run the concession stand. This is a problem that cannot continue to happen. Please remember to restock after your group's time in the stand.

## **Fundraising-**

**Discount Cards-** have been handed out to all groups wishing to sell them this year. Dr. Gorey has 100 cards left. Anyone wishing to get a card please contact her.

**Check Awards-** 1500 books have been handed out to the organizations selling them this fall. Organizations have until October 5<sup>th</sup> to turn in money or unused books. In the reorder for the fall there are a few different establishments than there were in the spring books. Next reorder will be in the spring with new vendors. \$17,000 was raised in the spring. School made \$10,000; cost of books was \$7,000. As long as CLC continues to sell the books they are they only school in Crystal Lake that will be selling check awards. The Booster board is considering raising the price of the books to \$40 in the spring and give the Boosters \$5 each book sold. Gail Bauman thinks it would be better to keep the price of the books the same and give the organization less money per book.

**Walk-a-thon-** Will be held October 25<sup>th</sup> from 11-2. Students will get donations for walking a mile and then will receive a hotdog, pop and a bag of chips. Hopefully the junior class will participate to help raise money for Prom. Last year \$5000 was collected with a very small turnout. Carla Polk stated "She can not have her kids go to neighbors to collect money for them to walk" Gayle Wylde suggested that the groups give out thank you postcards with a picture of the team they will be sponsoring on it.

**Game Night-** will be held March 6 2010 at the Dole Mansion again this year. Debbie Freck handed out a sheet to all liaisons in attendance explaining about Game Night. That way the fall sports can start collecting items or money now when their teams are together. More information to come.

**Chili's Night and Nicks Pizza Night-** Chili's and Nicks contacted Bob this summer and said they would have a night where they will give a percentage back to the school if the patrons turned in a **Coupon** supplied by the school. Nicks night will be September 10<sup>th</sup> and will give 15% back to Central. Chili's will be every Wednesday from September to December and will give 10% back in one check in Dec. You can get both **Coupons** on the booster website.

**Golf Outing 2010-** Sean Thomas and Bob Frazier will be the Chairs if now one else steps forward.

**New Business-** Glynette Major a volleyball parent wondered if she could sell Central Colored hand made earrings from the concession stand. She will be donating All money received to the volleyball program. Bob suggested that she talk to Doug Blundy and get permission from the administration to set up a table that she will man at volleyball games. The concession stand is too small to start having other items besides food in there. We are only allowed to sell prepackage food.
